Calculations

Rolling 5-Year Average Increase: The percentage increases for the most recent five years are calculated and then averaged: the salary for the previous year is subtracted from the current year and divided by the

FY Estimate: The salary estimate for the upcoming year is derived by multiplying the most recent salary for each rank by its rolling five year average increase.

Upper and lower limits: The upper and lower limits of the salary range for each rank are computed by multiplying the estimate for each rank by 105% and 90%, respectively.

Less than a Doctorate: The upper and lower limits of the salary range for each rank is equivalent to the salary ranges for doctoral qualified faculty multipled by 85%. This model is used for individuals who hold degrees less than a doctorate or a recognized equvialent.
